This list is a compilation of lists made by several different emergency response agencies. Those lists are divided into categories. This one is in alphabetical order so you can think about each item individually and decide if you want to include it in your kit. NO ONE NEEDS EVERYTHING ON THIS LIST!!!!! Think about your situation and the degree of comfort you wish to achieve. Be selective. Weight and space matter. Include only the things you will use. Package your kit so it's easy to carry and store it where it's easy to get.
